At the conclusion of our class, Riris brought her hands to her face and exclaimed “This is such a happy day—I am so happy!” Every time I remember Riris, I thank my God for her and the opportunity to have been to Indonesia. We pray for those who would consider partnering with us to spread the gospel in the Jakarta area. We thank God for the personal connections we have from human relationships we have already known, and those we have yet to meet.

As Scott begins preparations for another trip to Jakarta, we would like to share **some of the exciting things that God is doing:**

The **World Bible School lesson number five has been fully translated and sent on to the printer.** Two more are in the process of translation and formatting. **The radio program continues to reach out to new students.**

Through **Connor’s House** and those associated with it, we are assisting a

family with newborn triplets born in the seventh month. Milk products have to be imported and therefore

are expensive. We are providing Enfamil for the babies who live in a house 8’ X 9’ with their parents, a grandmother, and 11 brothers and sisters. Both parents work, but are unable to adequately provide for their large family.

Feeding the street children continues as we give cooked food to about 20 children each day. The dollar has lost 20% of its value since we started this program making it hard to reach our goals and some days we find special needs such as the triplets above that require more help than budgeted meaning we feed fewer kids than we want but we are still meeting the needs of these poorest of the poor in Jakarta

Tegar is now living at Connor’s House. He is healthy and growing, and appears to be meeting

physical and mental milestones on schedule.

The bank has approved the loan for the purchase of the house adjacent to Connor’s House. In the future, it will provide for living space for older children, as well as space to provide schooling for the children.
